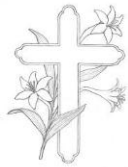

Gifts of bread and wine for the eucharistic feast and offerings of money for the life and ministry of the church are brought forward, to be consecrated and blessed.

## **Liturgy of the Table: Holy Communion**

All are welcome to come to the altar rail, and all who are drawn to God in the way of Jesus Christ are welcome to receive Holy Communion.

**The Lord's Prayer** BCP p. 336

Presider Alleluia. Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us.

People **Therefore let us keep the feast. Alleluia.**

To receive Communion: Please come to the rail and stand or kneel, leaving space between you and other groups. Wine-Host may be taken by sipping from the chalice or from the tray of individual servings. To receive a spoken blessing only, simply cross your arms in front of your chest. Gluten-free wafers are available by request at the rail. To receive Communion at your pew, please inform an usher.
