The People respond after each prayer bidding variously, as in the Book of Common Prayer. The Confession follows as part of the prayer form.

Absolution and bidding the Peace

Presider The peace of Christ be always with you.

People **And also with you.**

All are invited to share a sign of Christ’s peace. Announcements follow. Gifts of bread and wine for the table, and contributions toward the ministries of the church, are brought forward to be consecrated and blessed.

1. **We all are one in mission,
We all are one in call,
Our varied gifts united,
By Christ, the Lord of all.
A single, great commission,
Compels us from above,
To plan and work together,
That all may know Christ’s love.**

2. **We all are called for service,
To witness in God’s name.
Our ministries are different,
Our purpose is the same:
To touch the lives of others,
By God’s surprising grace,
So people of all nations,
May feel God’s warm embrace.**

4. **Now let us be united and let our song be heard.
Now let us be a vessel for God’s redeeming Word.
We all are one in mission, we all are one in call,
Our varied gifts united by Christ, the Lord of all.**

Liturgy of the Table: Holy Communion

All are welcome to come to the altar rail. All who are drawn to God in the way of Jesus Christ are welcome to receive Holy Communion in the community of Trinity Church. Instructions for receiving sacramental Communion follow the Great Thanksgiving.

The Great Thanksgiving

Eucharistic Prayer B, BCP p. 367

The people remain standing. The Presider, whether bishop or priest, faces them and sings or says

People The Lord be with you.
Presider **And also with you.**
People Lift up your hearts.
Presider **We lift them to the Lord.**
People Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
Presider **It is right to give God thanks and praise.**

The Great Thanksgiving continues with praise to God for the work of creation through Christ, as appropriate to the day or season.

Sanctus

Hymnal 1982 S-125

The Great Thanksgiving continues with a history of God’s love, to include Jesus’s last meal with his followers in the event of the Last Supper. The Presider then asks the congregation to affirm the faith of the Church

Presider Therefore, according to his command, O Father,
People **We remember his death,
We proclaim his resurrection,
We await his coming glory;**

The Great Thanksgiving concludes with asking God the Holy Spirit to sanctify the feast and all who partake and praising God, concluding

Presider ...By him, and with him, and in him, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, all honor and glory is yours,
Almighty Father, now and forever.
People **AMEN.**

The Lord's Prayer *(said)*

**Our Father, who art in heaven,
hallowed be thy Name,
thy kingdom come,
thy will be done,
on earth as it is in heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread.
And forgive us our trespasses,**

**as we forgive those
who trespass against us.
And lead us not into temptation,
but deliver us from evil.
For thine is the kingdom,
and the power, and the glory,
for ever and ever. Amen.**

Breaking of the Bread and Invitation

Presider Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us;

People **Therefore let us keep the feast.**

On Receiving Holy Communion: *All are welcome to come to the altar rail. Those wishing to share in Communion should stand or kneel and extend their hands, palms up. Gluten-free wafers are available upon request. Wine-host may be received by sipping directly from the chalice or from the tray of individual servings. If you would like instead a spoken blessing from the priest, please cross your arms over your chest.*
