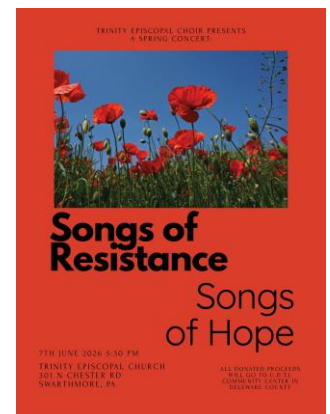
Open House for renovated "Trinity House"
